- Long hair should be tied back at all times with ribbons, bows, hairbands or bobbles in school colours.

- Jewellery should not be worn to school, children who have their ears pierced should wear studs not earrings.

# What to bring to School!



Please have the following items with you every day!

- 2 sharp pencils
  - 1 ruler
  - 1 rubber
  - 1 Sharpener
- 1 packet of Colouring Pencils/Twistables
  - 1 Glue Stick
- 3 Pens, Black/Blue/Red
  - 1 Highlighter
- A box of Tissues
- An A4 Zipped durable homework folder to keep homework files and school books in. A reinforced sturdy folder called Tuff bags are quite good as they are more likely to last through the year. These are reinforced with mesh.

Please ensure stationary is labelled with your child's name as they can easily get mixed up or lost.

## At the start of the year

- Please ensure that you bring your completed homework in each morning and that it is signed by a parent!
- Children can bring a bottle of water only to school each day. Please ensure it has a sealed top and won't leak!
